Sail a Yacht or a Catamaran. (half day minimum). An activity designed for beginners or for accomplished participants. We provide students with quality sailing yachts that are ideal for learning or for enjoying cruises round the nearby islands. Monohull yachts are used for small groups. Multi-hulls for larger groups and racing yachts for students who have previous skills and experience.

Sail a Dinghy

Sail in Asia provide schools with an introduction to sailing a dinghy. The students can learn on a performance dinghy (fast and furious) or a cruising dinghy (fun with time to catch your breath). Instruction is of a high quality and the dinghies are safe and in good condition.

Canoeing

A great way to spend an hour or half hour. Learn the basics in ten minutes and then make your way along the beautiful beach of Ao Yon and explore the coastline within site of our base. Safety cover supplied with the group.

Power boating - an activity that allows a small group (8 max) to go to a local island for swimming, snorkelling and beach rambling.

Dragonboating - Teams are formed and within 15 minutes the students are briefed and skilled sufficiently to take to the water with their instructor! Form two teams and RACE! This is great fun and requires good teamwork and coordination. Up to six boats are available with opportunities for School Regattas
